

## **GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF SUMMARIES ON ISSUES RELATED TO THE MAIN THEMES (NON-SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH)**

All non-scientific research summaries submitted to the Technical Scientific Committee for evaluation and approval should meet the following criteria. All non-scientific research summaries should be sent by e-mail to [expositores@congresomundialquinua.com](mailto:expositores@congresomundialquinua.com) Cc: [informes@congresomundialquinua.com](mailto:informes@congresomundialquinua.com). A summary should be no longer than one page (450 words approximately), without tables, charts or figures. All summaries should be written in Spanish or English, in one paragraph, single-line spacing, Times New Roman, 12-point font size, left and right margins must be 3 cm. All PDF summaries will be published in a “flash memory, pen drive or electronic storage device” as they were sent or delivered. Typos and writing mistakes are the responsibility of the author. The summary should contain the following sections: title, author(s), organization, city and country, background, objective of the study, materials and methods, results, discussion, conclusions, and key words. The title must be written in bold, capital letters, followed in another line by the author’s last name and initials in capital letters, and the name of the organization(s), city, country and author’s e-mail address. The name of the person who will present the work must be underlined. Leave a blank line before the initial paragraph. The deadline for submission of research summaries is December 30, 2016. Upon approval by the Technical Scientific Committee in charge of the evaluation, you will be notified of your participation and incorporation in the final program of the congress. Each leading author will be able to present up to two scientific works as a conference or poster (1.2 x 1.4 m). You will be notified by e-mail about the day and time of your presentation, your reference number and the details regarding your placement in the program. The summaries approved by the Technical Scientific Committee will be received in their extended version (Spanish and English) until January 30, 2017 for their incorporation in the report of the congress. You will be notified about this at the right time.
